- ❖ Mammoth Mountain Resort www.mammothmountain.com
- ❖ Skiing/snowboarding- 3,500 acres of rideable terrain. An average snowfall of 400 inches from November through June allows for riding and exploring natural hits, gullies, heart-pumping steep chutes, wide-open bowls, tree riding and wide-open cruisers. Consistently sunny skies, expansive challenging terrain and outstanding terrain parks have created a winter paradise.
- ❖ Sledding/Tubing- Take the family to the Sled park Sledz - 760-934-7533 or sled anywhere on the Scenic Loop Road.
- ❖ Cross Country Skiing- The [Tamarack Cross Country Ski Center](#) and the public [Mammoth Lakes Nordic Trail System](#), offer miles of trails and skating lanes for Nordic skiers.
- ❖ [Disabled Sports Eastern Sierra](#), located at Mammoth Mountain, offers life-enhancing experiences to people with physical or cognitive disabilities
- ❖ [Parallax Snowcat Dinners](#) is a dining adventure at 9,600 feet. Starting with a champagne reception followed by a luxury snowcat ride high on Mammoth Mountain to Parallax. Sophisticated American cuisine is highlighted by constantly changing 3 and 4-course menu options. 800-626-6684

- ❖ Ice-skating- Mammoth Ice Rink is an outdoor facility located in the Town of Mammoth Lakes offering public skating sessions, pick-up hockey, and lessons
- ❖ Dog Sledding Tours-dogsled rides for families of all ages with friendly huskies and malamutes. In the summer, they offer kennel tours. Mammoth Dogsled rides depart from two places, depending on the snow conditions: Smoky Bear Flats (on Hwy. 395 a few miles north of Mammoth Lakes) or Mammoth Mountain Inn (next to Main Lodge). There are also Dog Sled Dinner Rides where you "Mush" along under a star-filled sky to the spectacular Minaret Vista and watch the Sierra sunset followed by a delicious dinner at the Mountainside Grill. 760-934-6270

- ❖ Fishing (Twin Lakes, Lake Mary, Lake Mamie, Lake George, Horseshoe Lake) Mono County fishing season starts the last Saturday in April and ends on November 15th of every year, however, the catch and release fisheries of the Upper Owens River above the Benton Bridge to Big Springs, the East Walker River below Bridgeport Reservoir, and Hot Creek, will remain open year round. <http://www.dfg.ca.gov>

- ❖ Motorcross- Owens Valley offers hundreds of miles of year-round dirt-biking terrain
- ❖ Wildlife Viewing- Mammoth Lakes offers opportunities to see birds, bears, mountain lions, marmots, mule deer, tule elk, wild mustangs, bighorn sheep, chickarees, coyotes and pine marten.

- ❖ Mammoth Ski Museum- www.mammothskimuseum.org One of the largest single collections covering 500 years of skiing, art and memorabilia.
- ❖ Mammoth Lakes Art Center- Offers a dose of culture in it's theatre
- ❖ Shopping- shops and boutiques offering fine apparel, arts, and handcrafts, gifts, T-shirts, Mammoth Lakes Souvenirs, sweet shops, brand factory outlets and outdoor gear.
- ❖ Yosemite National Park- The eastern gate into Yosemite National Park (Tioga Pass Hwy 120) is just 45 minutes north of Mammoth Lakes. One of the world's most spectacular natural wonders. <http://www.nps.gov/yose/playourvisit/placestogo.htm>
- ❖ June Lake/Mountain Ski Resort- With 500 acres of skiable terrain and 7 chairs, June Mountain offers lift-accessed backcountry as well as a full mountain of skiing/snowboarding.
- ❖ Convict Lake- Located 10 miles south of the Mammoth Lakes, the is the site of the 1871 gun battle between escaped convicts and a sheriff's posse. The oldest rocks in the Sierra Nevada range were discovered here. Great for picnicking, fishing, hiking, horseback riding, boating and camping.
- ❖ Mono Lake- Located 30 miles north of Mammoth Lakes, this inland sea is known for its bird population, scenic value and delicate tufa formations.
- ❖ Ancient Bristlecone Pine Forest

- ❖ [Hot Creek Geologic Site](#)- live hot springs and fumaroles (gas vents) which heat a cold mountain stream. Parking lot and restrooms. Open sunrise to sunset; no charge. Hot Creek is Closed to Swimming due to varying temperatures of the water.
- ❖ Red Meadows/Devil's Postpile National Monument/Rainbow Falls- a historical attraction 10 miles from Main Lodge in Mammoth Lakes
- ❖ Minarets

- ❖ Bodie Ghost Town- the largest unrestored ghost town in the West featuring weathered buildings, a museum and a visitor center.
